Youth in Mind is a one day conference held as part of the 4th Annual Divisions of General Practice Network Forum on the 7 November 2002. It is hosted by the National Divisions Youth Alliance (NDYA) and National Mental Health programs within the Australian Divisions of General Practice (ADGP).

The aim of *Youth in Mind* is to provide the opportunity for the Divisions Network*, GPs, Youth Mental Health Stakeholders, Young People and Carers, to come together and discuss the role of General Practice and Divisions in addressing mental health issues affecting young people.

The conference themes are:

Building Partnerships >> Sharing Knowledge >> Supporting Participation

There will be a number of opportunities in concurrent sessions and the Divisions' Poster Display for Divisions of General Practice to showcase their outstanding work through invited and proffered papers.

The *Youth in Mind* Working Party invites expressions of interest from Divisions and Stakeholders wishing to present a paper in the concurrent sessions on Thursday, 7 November.

The themes of the sessions are:

- Engaging Young People.

About the National Divisions of General Practice Network Forum 2002

The theme of the National Divisions' Forum for 2002 is "Building Excellence in Primary Health Care". This theme has been chosen to reflect the role of Divisions in delivering services to general practices and communities, in building partnerships and bridges between general practice, the wider health sector and consumers, and in managing change in general practice and primary health care. It provides scope for consideration of how Divisions can build on their achievements over the past ten years, where the future might be leading us and, importantly, how we can work with our stakeholders to create a strong, vital primary health care sector to which general practice is integral.

The National Divisions' Forum, incorporating the *Youth in Mind* conference, will be held at the Brisbane Exhibition Centre from the 7 – 10 November 2002.

*The Divisions Network consists of the Australian Divisions of General Practice (ADGP), 8 State/Territory Divisions of General Practice offices (SBOs) and 121 Divisions of General Practice throughout Australia. Ninety-four percent of GP in Australia are members of the Divisions of General Practice Network.



Proffered Papers- Abstract Guidelines

Title

Aligned to left margin, capital letters, bold face, single spaced, do not underline, maximum two lines

Authors

Aligned to left margin, following the sequence: principal author, second author and third author

Do not include titles, degrees and appointments

Include presenter's name (if different from author/s)

Layout & Formatting

One A4 page (250-300 words max.) 25mm margins, no borders

Preferred font – Arial 12 point

Single spacing, one line between paragraphs, do not indent

Use upper and lower case except for author/s

Biography of presenter/s

A short biography of no more than 150 words should be provided on each of the presenters.

Materials to be distributed

A list of materials to be distributed at the concurrent session should also be provided.
